The instructor will discuss the legal/medical uses of Opiates.</li><li>3. Discuss Causative Agents of Opioid Overdose</li><li>4. Discuss the use/Therapeutic response of Opiates</li><li>5. Discuss symptoms of Opioid Overdose</li><li>6. Discuss Naloxone as an Opioid antagonist/Describe how Naloxone "works"</li><li>7. Explain benefits of intranasal naloxone as opposed to IV and discuss contraindications to intranasal use.</li><li>8. Discuss Naloxone precautions including opioid withdrawal symptoms and contacting EMS</li><li>9. Discuss possible side effects of Naloxone usage.</li><li>10. Discuss Naloxone dosage/pre-packaged nasal spray</li></ol>	Power Point (slides 3-24)
0845-0900	Administration of Naloxone nasal spray	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The instructor will explain proper administration technique of intranasal naloxone:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Discuss signs and symptoms of opioid overdose</li><li>-Ensure EMS has been notified</li><li>-Place patient in supine position</li><li>-Discuss universal precautions including the use of gloves and refraining from physical contact with nozzle of nasal spray</li><li>-Placement of nasal spray into patient unobstructed nostril</li></ul></li><li>2. Instructor will discuss post-administration management.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Dispose of intranasal spray appropriately</li><li>-Place the patient in the recovery position and protect their air way</li><li>-Ensure EMS is activated</li><li>-Monitor for side effects</li><li>-Reassess for need of another dose</li><li>-Advise EMS of patients response to naloxone</li></ul></li></ol>	Power Point (slides 25-27)
