

## Food Handlers' Education and Monitoring

### 1015.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for food handlers' education and monitoring. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

#### 1015.1.1 DEFINITIONS

Definition related to this policy include:

**Food handler** - Any person who works with food or food preparation utensils in a facility kitchen or area where food is prepared or distributed to youth or staff.

### 1015.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Board of State and Community Corrections Title 15 § 1465;
- Health and Safety Code § 113947.

### 1015.3 POLICY

Supervisory staff and food handlers shall receive ongoing training in safe food handling techniques, including personal hygiene, safety and security, in accordance with section 113947 of the Health and Safety Code, California Retail Food Code (CalCode). The procedures shall include provisions for monitoring compliance that ensure appropriate food handling and personal hygiene requirements.

### 1015.4 COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 113947

To comply with Health and Safety Code; Section 113947:

- (a) The food services manager/supervisor and all food employees shall have adequate knowledge of, and shall be properly trained in, food safety as it relates to their assigned duties.
- (b) The food services manager shall have adequate knowledge of and educate their employees in, major food allergens, foods identified as major food allergens, and the symptoms that a major food allergen could cause in a sensitive individual who has an allergic reaction.

### 1015.5 COMPLIANCE MONITORING

The food services manager/supervisor shall maintain records of all training as it relates to Health and Safety Code Section 113947. These training records shall be inspected periodically by the facility manager.
