

Clothing Exchange

1020.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy procedures for the laundering and exchange of clothing. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

1020.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

1020.3 POLICY

Youth shall be provided with clean clothes on a regular basis.

1020.4 FREQUENCY

Youth shall turn in clothes for laundering and receive clothing in exchange as follows, unless work, climatic conditions or illness necessitate more frequent exchanges:

- (a) Tee shirts, bras, socks, and underwear shall be laundered and exchanged at least daily. Youth shall receive their own issued underwear back after being laundered.
- (b) Outer clothing (sweatshirts, sweatpants, pants and shorts), physical education clothing, and youth nightwear shall be laundered and exchanged at least once weekly.
- (c) Issued clothing shall be clean, freshly laundered, in good repair and free of vermin.
- (d) Footwear shall be exchanged as needed.
- (e) Juvenile facility staff may approve additional clothing exchanges for youth under the discretion of the unit supervising probation officer (SPO).
