

Joint Armed and Unarmed Staff Activities

640.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

To set forth the guidelines and procedures for activities involving armed and unarmed deputies. This policy applies to all deputy probation officers.



640.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Executive Committee

640.3 POLICY

Armed deputies may assist unarmed deputies in supervision activities with the prior approval of the unit(s) supervisor(s).

640.4 PROCEDURE

- Unarmed deputies shall not routinely assist armed deputies in field supervision activities. As the need arises, unarmed deputies may seek the assistance of armed deputies for a specific activity, such as a search or arrest, by first reviewing the case with the immediate supervisor and submitting a written request. The supervisor may approve the joint involvement if determined that additional deputies are required to implement tactical procedures that will enhance deputy safety.
- Upon approval, the supervisor shall contact the armed unit/area office supervisor to request the assistance and coordinate implementation of the operation.
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- During the planning phase, the armed deputy's supervisor will designate responsibility for all tactical planning and decision-making.
