

Health Care Procedures Manual

986.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose is to establish and implement written policy and procedures for the development, implementation and maintenance of a facility-specific health services manual. This policy applies to all juvenile facility staff.

986.2 AUTHORITY AND REFERENCES

- Board of State and Community Corrections Title 15 § 1409;
- Riverside County Correctional Healthcare Services Policy G-107;
- Welfare and Institutions Code §§ 209, 210 & 885.

986.3 POLICY

Each facility-specific health services manual shall consist of written policies and procedures that address, at a minimum, all health care related standards that are applicable to the facility.

986.4 HEALTH CARE PROCEDURES MANUAL

Health care policy and procedure manuals shall be available to all health care staff, to the Chief Probation Officer, the facility manager(s) and other individuals as appropriate to ensure effective service delivery.

The policies and procedures of the health care system shall be consistent with the overall policies and procedures of the facility.

986.5 POLICY AND PROCEDURE UPDATES

Each policy and procedure for health care delivery system shall be reviewed at least every two years and revised as necessary under the direction of the health administrator. The health administrator shall develop a system to document this review occurs. The Chief Probation Officer, facility manager(s), health administrator and responsible physician shall designate their approval by signing the manual.
